

## Cocodona Driving Directions

- **Aravaipa Office** – 2401 South 24<sup>th</sup> Street, Phoenix.
- **Cocodona250 Start Line** – Deep Canyon Ranch. 18600 Deep Canyon Trail. Go through the gate (code is 3337), drive across the creek (safe to cross), pass the house on your right and the dumpster/equipment on the left, road curves to the right, arrive at the huge grass field. **DO NOT EXCEED 15MPH OR WE WILL NOT BE INVITED BACK NEXT YEAR.**
- **Cottonwood Creek** – Higher clearance vehicles without 4WD can make it but it is very rocky in places and you do have to cross the Agua Fria River. To get there, take I-17 to exit #236 Table Mesa Road and head northwest. The drive from I-17 takes about 1 hour. Obtain a gpx file with the driving route from the Race Director.
- **Lane Mtn** – Drive to Crown King Saloon which is drivable by all passenger cars but it is a LONG WASHBOARD road. When you reach Crown King, instead of turning right into the main area of town, continue straight for 0.75 miles to an intersection. The intersection has a sign with “right to Prescott” or “straight to Horsethief Basin”, stay straight towards Horsethief Basin. After 3.8 miles of driving from the main intersection in Crown King you will arrive at the intersection of FR100 at FR9258A. Setup the aid station in the parking area of this intersection (see layout in binder). Coordinates are 34.1688, -112.3237.
- **Crown King** – Crown King Saloon located at 7219 Main St, Crown King, AZ. Parking is extremely limited, please carpool if possible. Volunteers are asked to park at the Crown King Forest Service Ranger Station. To get to the Ranger Station, drive to the Crown King Saloon, drive past the Saloon, take your first left after the Saloon, and drive to 0.25 mile. Park and walk back to the Crown King Saloon. GPS coordinates of the Ranger Station are 34.206049, -112.342315.
- **Arrastra Creek** – 34.3318, -112.3721. Not advisable in passenger cars. 2 ROUTES:
  - Starting in Mayer AZ off of Hwy69 navigate to Jefferson Rd. Drive southwest on Jefferson Rd (also named Pine Flats Rd) for 11.4 miles at which point you will cross a small seasonal creek, after the creek crossing turn left onto Senator Highway (FR52). Drive for 2 miles on Senator Highway and see the aid station location on your left at a dirt parking area off of the road.
  - If you are driving from Crown King – VERY rough and slow going route that only saves a few minutes from the route above. Leave Crown King by turning right on Crown King Rd and in 0.75 miles turn right on Senator Hwy – FR52 North toward Prescott. Continue on Senator Hwy – FR52 North for 15.3 miles and you will arrive at the aid station location, a dirt parking area on the right side off of the road.
- **Kamp Kippa** – Location is 34.4118, -112.4181. TWO OPTIONS:
  - From Prescott – In some spots this road gets a bit rough but it is ok for passenger cars. From Prescott, drive south on Mount Vernon Ave (eventually becomes Senator Highway / FR52). Start your odometer when you pass Haisley Rd. Continue

11.7 miles on Senator Highway where the dirt road will become increasingly steep and switch-backing. After 11.7 miles you will arrive at a 5-way intersection. Do not turn right to cross a cattle-guard going downhill on Senator Highway. Instead, continue straight (not crossing the cattleguard) to go uphill on Poland Rd (FR261) toward Mount Union. After 1.1 miles, turn left into Kamp Kippa. Drive all the way to the bottom of the hill. Aid Station is at the bottom of the hill in the large building.

- From everywhere else – From Hwy69 between Meyer / Dewey-Humbolt. At Hwy69 mile marker 275 turn on to Poland Road (FR267) and head southwest. Reset odometer and after 12.9 miles, turn right into Kamp Kippa. In the past, Poland road has been treacherous at the top but the road has now been improved.

- **Camp Wamatochick** – 5101 S. Senator Hwy, Prescott.
- **Whiskey Row** – Grand Highland Hotel at 154 Whiskey Row, Prescott, AZ. Parking in downtown Prescott can be very tough during the day. There is a parking garage located behind the aid station on Granite Street. The parking garage has low overhead clearance. For staff loading and unloading, you can temporarily park behind the hotel in the alley.
- **Mingus Traverse Packet Pickup** – Springhill Suites, 200 East Sheldon Street, Prescott.
- **Mingus Traverse Start Line** – Watson Lake Park located at 3101 Watson Lake Rd, Prescott. Enter the park and drive straight (no turns) until you dead end into a parking lot. The start line is over past the big gazebo. Exact location of the start line is 34.59085, -112.42044.
- **Iron King** – Dirt parking area along the north side of Santa Fe Loop Road at approximately 5851 E Santa Fe Loop Rd, Prescott Valley, AZ.
- **Fain Ranch** – Arizona Downs Racetrack at 10501 E. State Route 89A, Prescott Valley, AZ. Turn into the complex from Hwy 89A and drive all the way to the back of the property, turn left when the road dead-ends, then drive straight until you arrive at the aid station. Aid Station is located at 34.64511, -112.27942.
- **Mingus Mountain Camp** – 8500 W. Forest Service Rd 104, Prescott Valley, AZ. From Prescott Valley drive north (east) on Hwy89A as it climbs up Mingus Mountain over numerous switchbacks. Turn right at the summit, Mingus Recreation Area (FR104). After 1.4 miles the pavement turns to dirt. Continue another 0.9 miles and arrive at Mingus Camp on your left. No dogs allowed.
- **Sedona Canyons 125 Start Line** – Gold King Mine Ghost Town, 1000 Perkinsville Rd, Jerome.
- **Jerome Historic State Park** – 100 Douglas Rd, Jerome. Volunteers please park in the dirt parking area on your right just before entering the park.
- **Dead Horse Ranch State Park** – 675 Dead Horse Ranch Rd, Cottonwood. Mention you are volunteering for the Cocodona race and you will not need to pay the park entrance fee. After entering the park take your first left into the group camping area. Volunteers are asked to park on Owl Road (first road on the right after entering the park).

- **Deer Pass Trailhead** – Coordinates of aid station are 34.81329, -111.9005. From Cottonwood drive north on Hwy89A. At mile marker 364.2 turn right at Deer Pass Rd (FR89B). Continue 1/2 mile to the aid station, a trailhead parking area on your right. Parking is extremely tight at this location and volunteers are asked to park at one of the other parking areas along the road and walk to the aid station.
- **Sedona Water Station** – Schuerman Mountain Trailhead located at Red Rock High School. Exact location is 34.846005, -111.828577.
- **Sedona Posse Grounds** – Posse Grounds Park, 525 Posse Ground Rd, Sedona, AZ. When you enter the park there is a fork, take the right fork and park in the large parking area on your left. The aid station is located down the street and across the road from the parking lot, inside the HUB building just north of the Jack Malmgren Memorial Skate Park.
- **Sedona Ranger Station / Mingus Traverse Finish Line** – Sedona Ranger Station Park, 250 Brewer Rd, Sedona. Volunteers are asked to park up the hill in the LDS Church parking lot at 160 Mormon Hill Rd, Sedona and walk back down to the aid station.
- **Mingus Traverse Finish Line Parking (Pre-Race Shuttle Pick-up Location)** – The LDS Church parking lot at 160 Mormon Hill Rd, Sedona.
- **Foxboro Ranch** – 20921 Schnebly Hill Rd, Sedona. DO NOT drive up Schnebly Hill Rd directly from Sedona. From Sedona, drive south to the Village Of Oak Creek and then north on I-17. From I-17 take exit #320 (Schnebly Hill) and drive 1.5 miles west on FR153 Schnebly Hill Rd (Do NOT take the Fox Ranch Exit). After entering ranch, turn right at T-intersection. Aid station is in the huge barn.
- **Crystal Point** (Sedona Canyons 125 Restart Location) – 1432 Mormon Lake Rd, Munds Park. From I-17, take exit #322 (Munds Park) and drive 2.1 miles east on Pinewood Blvd. Road turns to dirt when it hits the forest FR240. Just after the road turns to dirt, the trailhead is on the left. 34.93911, -111.61967.
- **Munds Park** – Munds Park Community Church, 17670 S Munds Ranch Rd, Munds Park. Turn left directly after the church and the aid station is BEHIND the church.
- **Sedona Canyons 125 Pacer Swap parking location** – Exit I-17 at Newman Park exit #328, turn to the East and then take your first right so that you are driving parallel with I-17 headed south. Drive 0.5 miles and park on the left. 35.01187, -111.68437
- **Sedona Canyons 125 Pacer Swap hike in location** – From the parking area, hike east into the forest 0.7 miles. No support for runners. Only pacer swap. 35.014394, -111.677052.
- **Kelly Canyon** – From I-17 take exit #331 onto FR700 (Kelly Canyon Rd) east for 0.5 miles and arrive at trailhead parking area on your left. 35.056371, -111.678313.
- **Homestead** – From I-17 take exit #333 onto Mountaineer Road and drive East for 1.9miles then turn left onto Osage Rd. Then multiple turns in a short distance; Left on Shoshone St, Right on Kiowa St, Right on Comanche St, Left on Bannock, and a Right on Kiowa. After 0.5miles Kiowa curves to the right. Just after the curve, turn Left onto

Homestead Rd (sometimes Homestead is also labeled Cado or Comanche). Drive 0.7 miles on Homestead Rd and arrive at the aid station on your right. 35.085676, -111.641281.

- **Fort Tuthill** – 2446 Fort Tuthill Loop Rd, Flagstaff. Enter the park and follow signs for Adventure X Extreme and then park in the huge parking lot. Walk towards all of the white buildings and the Aid Station is inside of the Quad (between all of the buildings) inside of the largest building.
- **Walnut Canyon** – Location at 35.1803, -111.5323. Your phone directions take you one of two different directions, do not take the route from Country Club Dr. Take I-40 East from Flagstaff. Take exit 204 for Walnut Canyon and turn right. In 2.5 miles turn right on Old Walnut Canyon Rd. In 1.7 miles arrive at the aid station. The last mile of this drive is VERY rough but can be accessed in a passenger car if you choose your line wisely. Parking is extremely tight at this location and volunteers are asked to park at one of the other parking areas along the road and walk to the aid station.
- **Wildcat Hill** – Fire Department Training Center, 2800 N El Paso Rd, Flagstaff.
- **Trinity Heights** – Trinity Heights United Methodist Church, 3600 N 4<sup>th</sup> Street, Flagstaff. Aid Station is located in the parking lot behind the church.
- **Bow & Arrow** – Location at 35.184347, -111.630896. From I-40 take exit #198 Butler Avenue and turn to go West on Butler Ave. At the first light, turn left onto Butler Avenue West. At the first light, turn left onto Babbitt Drive. The road curves a few times and you arrive at a gate. The gate should be unlocked or dummy locked. Close the gate behind yourself and DO NOT LOCK IT. Go through the under pass, continue around the curve to the left, and under the bridge. When the road curves right towards the next gated building, stay straight to go off of the paved road and onto a dirt road. There may be a pipe bollard sticking out of the ground. Lift the pipe bollard out of the ground, replace it behind yourself, and drive down the dirt road to the aid station. Park on the left and KEEP THE DIRT ROAD OPEN AT ALL TIMES.
- **Sinclair Wash** – 1170 W Purple Sage Trail, Flagstaff. 35.15157, -111.68984.
- **Woody Mountain** – 35.16353, -111.70153. Easiest directions to this location are to plug the coordinates into your phone.
- **FAC** – Small parking lot across the street from the Flagstaff Athletic Club located at 1200 Historic Route 66, Flagstaff. Volunteers are asked to park at the Home Depot across the street and walk to the aid station.
- **Cherry / Beaver Lot (Cocodona250 & Sedona Canyons 125 Pre-Race Shuttle Parking)** – Parking lot at the NW corner of Cherry St and Beaver Ave. This is a CITY OF FLAGSTAFF PAID PARKING LOT.
- **Flagstaff LDS Church Parking Lot (Flagstaff Crest Pre-Race Shuttle Parking)** – LDS Church at 625 E Cherry Ave, Flagstaff.
- **Heritage Square (Cocodona250, Sedona Canyons 125, & Flagstaff Crest Finish Lines)** – Heritage Square, 6 E. Aspen Ave, Flagstaff. ANY STAFF making deliveries should park in the



6 closed off parking spaces along Aspen Street directly in front of Heritage Square. Parking in Flagstaff can be a pain. Mostly it is metered spaces. We have a free parking lot 0.6 miles east of Heritage Square at the LDS Church at 625 E Cherry Ave, Flagstaff. A continuous shuttle will be operating between this LDS Church parking lot and Heritage Square on Friday May 9<sup>th</sup> from 10am-9pm.
